That the custody, charge and care of the infant child shall remain with the said Rosa Whitfield, that the surname of Johnson be restored to the said Rosa Whitfield, and that the Plaintiff recover from the Defendant her costs by her expended in the prosecution of this suit. Nothing further remaining to be done in this suit, it is ordered that the same be removed from the Docket but leave is granted to the Parties to make application to the Court for such further orders as are authorized by law.

This cause came on this day to be again heard on the papers formerly read and on the Report of Special Commissioner Wm. H. Parker this day returned and the statement of J. J. Britlow, administrator filed therewith, to which report no exception is taken, and was argued by counsel on Consideration whereof it appearing to the Court that all the heirs of Wm. A. Massenburg deceased have united in a sale of the tract of land in the proceedings mentioned at private sale, and that they are all of age and that they have placed in the hands of the administrator a sum sufficient to pay all the debts ascertained to be due by said estate including that due the administrator, the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that so much of the decree entered in this cause at the November Term 1879 as directed the said Special Commissioner to make sale of the tract of land which Wm. A. Massenburg died seized for the purpose of paying the debts due by the decedent's estate, be now set aside. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that the said J. J. Britlow Administrator of said Wm. A. Massenburg deceased, after paying the unpaid costs of this suit do apply the said sum of two thousand and sixty seven and 7/100 Dollars received by him from the heirs of said Wm. A. Massenburg deceased out of said sale, towards the payment of the debts due by the estate of said Wm. A. Massenburg deceased, as shown by the report of Commissioner Selwell filed herein Oct. 25th 1879, with interest on the principal thereof from Nov. 1. 1879 to the date of this decree to be added in each case to the sum reported by said Commissioner and to pay
