This day this cause came on to be further heard on the papers formerly read and upon the report of W. W. Briggs M. Tauxford and A. O. Stephenson, Commissioners, to which report there is no exception, and was argued by Counsel on consideration whereof the Court doth adjourn and confirm the said Report, and doth adjudge, order and decree that the said Report, and doth adjudge, order and decree that Jno. C. Griffin and J. D. Prince, who are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose, either of whom may act, do proceed after having advertised the time place and terms of sale, in seven or more public places in this County, in the Norfolk Virginian for three Weeks and Franklin "Gazette" once a week for four weeks, to sell the Real Estate in the proceedings mentioned of which Bartholomew Baumer died seized, upon the following Terms to wit... one third of Cash, the balance on a credit of one and two years, the purchasers to give Bonds of equal amounts carrying interest from day of sale, with security to be approved by the Commissioners, the title to be retained for the further order of Court. That Commissioner is hereby authorized to put the purchaser in possession January 1st 1881 of said land, with the express understanding however that should the sale not be confirmed, the said purchaser will have to surrender possession of said land January 1st 1882, and pay for the said land a rent for year 1881 to be ascertained by reference to a Commissioner of this Court. And the said purchaser will not be allowed to cut any timber except for forming pierspost from the said farm, until the sale is confirmed. The Court doth further decree that the said Jno. C. Griffin Commissioner as aforesaid, deposit the amount of Cash he shall receive with the Banking House of Bain & Ross of Portsmouth & take certificate of deposit in his name as above, in this sum therefore and return the same with his report. But the said Commissioner will not proceed to execute this writ, entail, they or one of them shall have entered into Bond before the Clerk of this Court in the penalty of Fifteen Thousand Dollars with security to be approved by said Clerks conditioned to faithfully execute this and any further decree in this cause. And the said Courts will report to County
