It is ordered by the Court that the last decree entered in this cause be amended so as to embrace the following. "And it being suggested to the Court that there is now depending in this Court, a suit brought by the heirs at law of B. Bowers decd. against Elizabeth & Catharine Council, which has for its object a judicial construction of the Will of said Bowers, so far as to determine what are the rights of said Elizabeth & Catharine Council under said will, the Court doth order that the said suit and this suit be consolidated & hereafter brought on to be heard together, and that the order of sale for the real estate of which B. Bowers died seized be amended so as to conclude as follows: "But the said Elizabeth & Catharine Council are not to be disposed of of their present occupancy until it is determined by this Court what their rights are under the Will of said B. Bowers, and in the event it should be determined that they have any rights in the real estate of which B. Bowers died seized, ^{under the Will} ~~under the Will~~ of said B. Bowers, then by consent of ^{themselves} ~~themselves~~ they cannot, they relinquish said interest in the real estate and agree to accept a pecuniary consideration, to be determined by proper referees out of the proceeds of said

All matters and causes depending in this Court not otherwise disposed of, are generally continued until the first day of the next Term.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until the first day of the next Term.
