This cause this day came on again to be heard on the papers
 formerly read and the report of Commissioner Griffin this day filed by
 leave of the Court and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof
 the Court notwithstanding confirming and affecting said report doth adjudge, order
 and decree that the said Commissioner Griffin is hereby directed to forthwith
 from the papers in this cause, after filing with the Clerk of this Court a
 receipt for the same, the bonds of J. Lewis now unpaid and collect at the
 same forthwith and pay over the amount so collected to the parties entitled
 thereto under decree in this cause, and return his receipt to Court along
 with his report. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that
 A. B. Griffin who is appointed a Special Commissioner for that purpose,
 execute and deliver to M. E. Daughtry a good and perfect deed with special
 warranty, for that part of the No. 11 lot of land situated in the town of
 Franklin, Virginia, designated in a former report in this cause as lot
 No. 2 of which the said M. E. Daughtry became purchaser under a former
 decree of this Court, and bounded as follows: Commencing at the inter-
 section of Main Street and the line of the Bennett hotel lot, thence north
 along Main Street 27 1/2 feet, thence along a line at right angles with
 Main Street 82 1/2 feet to Bennett lot, thence south along the line of Bennett
 lot 100 feet, thence east to Main Street the point of beginning, and thence
 report to Court in order to a further decree.

 \$163.24 and their legal costs in this suit expended including the legal attorney's
 fee of \$15 an or before the first of December 1881, then the Sheriff of Southampton
 after reasonable notice shall rent at public auction to the highest bidder the
 tract of 1011 acres of land now held, owned and occupied by William H.
 Drewry at Drewry's will for the year 1881 taking from the bond with
 approval of Court and return the said bond along with his report in
 order to a further decree of this Court.
