An the motion of the defendants Minerva White, Picarra Australia  
White and Leonidas White there is given the said defendants to Minerva  
White in her own right and as administrator of Edwin P White deceased,  
and the defendants Picarra Australia White and Leonidas P White to  
file their separate answers in their cause and the sum is accordingly done  
and thereupon the Court doth appoint James R Pyler the guardian ad litem  
of the infant defendants Mrs Wilkins White, Eliza P White, Belle P White  
and Minerva P White to defend their interests in this cause whereupon the  
said guardian ad litem by leave of the Court filed the answer of the said  
infant defendants to the Plaintiff's bill and the plaintiff filed a general  
replevin to all of said answer. In this cause came an writ to be  
had on the said Complaintants bill and the answer of all the defendants  
and was argued by Counsel on conciliation where the Court doth adjudge  
order and decree that this cause be referred to James R Pyler one of the  
Commissioners in Chancery of this County, who is directed to take the  
following account 1<sup>st</sup> an account of the real and personal estate of  
which the late Edwin P White died seized & possessed 2<sup>nd</sup> an account of  
the debts and liabilities of the said Edwin P White at the time of his death  
The said Commissioner is also directed to ascertain whether during the  
lifetime of the said Edwin P White the said decedent made a gift to the  
plaintiff of the tract of land first described in the Complaintants bill and  
if yes then what was the consideration of the said gift and whether the said  
plaintiff have been induced to make expenditures of money and valuable  
improvements on the said land and all the other facts connected therewith  
The said Commissioner will also ascertain the same facts in regard to  
the land claimed by the defendant Leonidas P White under a gift from  
the said decedent. And the Court doth further adjudge order and decree that  
R W Branch, Eleanor Stiner and Edwin H Scarborough, any two of  
whom may act, who are hereby appointed special Commissioners for that  
purpose to after being first duly sworn meet upon the premises or out  
of which the said Edwin P White died seized and lay off and allot  
to the said defendant Minerva White his do over in the said lands and  
in allotting the same the said Commissioner will make a separate  
allotment to the two tracts claimed by the said plaintiff and the  
defendant Leonidas P White. And the further Consideration of this cause  
is adjourned.
