This cause was again heard this day and the papers formerly read and the report of Commissioners Ed. Story J. W. Williams and A. B. Peltore to which no exceptions have been filed and was argued by Counsel in consideration whereof the Court confirming said report doth adjudge order and decree that the tract of land mentioned and described in the complainants bill be sold at public auction to the highest bidder before the door of the Court house of Southampton County, after thirty days notice of said sale to be published in four or more public places in the County of Southampton and for four successive weeks in the Franklin Gazette as specified in the decree of Franklin Southampton County, on the following terms to wit: and fourth in cash the balance and a credit of one two and three years equal installments the purchaser to give bonds with sufficient personal security for the deferred payments, the title to be retained until the further order of the Court and for the purpose of executing this decree Robert Whitehead is hereby appointed a special Commissioner to sell said tract of land; but he shall not proceed to act as such until he shall have executed in the Clerk's office of this Court before the Clerk thereof a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars, conditional for the faithful performance of the conditions of this decree and all other decrees to be entered in in this suit. And the said Robert Whitehead Commissioner, so appointed is ordered to report to this Court his proceedings herein in order to be final decree.

This day this cause came on to be further heard on the papers formerly read and was argued by Counsel. And it appearing to the Court that Martha A. Whitehead, widow of William A. Whitehead died has been duly summoned to appear and show cause why the land bought by William A. Whitehead died of Mrs. Clements vs. B. Hayden Comm. should not be sold to pay Mrs. A. Hayden the amount he has been forced to pay as security for said Whitehead for the purchase of said land and she failing to appear and show any cause the Court doth adjudge order and decree that Mrs. A. Haydelly be the is hereby appointed a Commissioner to sell the said land. And he sell the same after 30 days public notice of time and place upon the following terms to wit: and first cash the balance and a credit of twelve months the purchaser to give bonds with good security carrying interest from day of sale and the title to be retained for the deferred payments until if the purchaser desire to pay the whole amount in cash the Court is authorized to receive the same. But the said Haydelly will not proceed to execute this decree until he shall have entered into bond before the Clerk of this Court in the penalty of \$1500 with security to be approved by said Clerk conditional to faithfully execute this and any further decree in this cause and the said Haydelly will report his proceedings to Court.
