This day, this Cause came on again
 to be heard on the papers formerly read and
 the report of Special Commissioner Robert White-
 head this day filed by leave of the Court and
 was argued by Counsel. On consideration where-
 the Court confirming said report doth adjudge
 order and decrees that Commissioner Whitehead
 after paying the unpaid Cost of this writ pay
 out of the funds now remaining in his hands
 of the cash payment made on the day of sale
 of the tract of lands mentioned in said report
 to the heirs at law of James Whitehead deceased
 as they are severally entitled thereto, except in
 the case of the infant children of Jesse White-
 head deceased one of the heirs at law of the
 said Jos. Whitehead deceased, whose distribution
 share, the said Commissioner is directed to pay
 to their legal guardians. And the Court doth
 further adjudge order and decree, that the said
 Commissioner Whitehead shall, with draw for Cal-
 lation, after filing with the clerk of this Court
 a receipt for the same, the bonds filed with
 his report as they severally become due and
 payable; but should the purchasers of said
 land desire to pay all of said bonds before
 their maturity, the said Commissioner is hereby
 directed to withdraw them at once and collect
 the same, due, with interest thereon, and pay
 the same to the heirs at law of the said Jos.
 Whitehead deceased as above directed as to
 balance of cash now in hand, taking their
 receipts for the same, and report to Court his
 proceedings under this decree.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow
 morning at 9 o'clock.
