In the Circuit Court of the County
of Southampton. This cause came on this
day to be heard on the Bill taken for Confess
as to the adult defendants upon whom proof
has been duly served, they still failing to
appear, pleads answer as demur, upon the
answer of the infant defendant by guardian
ad litem, with general replication thereto, and
was argued by Counsel. On consideration where-
of the Court doth adjudge, order and decree
that partition be made of the tract of land
in the bill mentioned of which Wm. Binford
died seized and possessed in the County of
Southampton as follows, to wit, ^{1/3} thereof
to C. F. Fairson wife of Pembroke Fairson ^{1/3}
thereof to the said Pembroke Fairson and ^{1/3}
thereof to Mary A. McClelland infant, Orphan
of ^{1/3} Mary McClelland dec'd formerly Bin-
ford and for the purpose of effecting such
partition, the Court doth order that A. S.
Holloman, John J. Bowden, Ranson Carroll
J. F. Ramsey & T. O'Brien, who are hereby appoin-
ted Commissioners for that purpose, any three
of whom may act, do assign and allote to
the several persons before named, the respect-
ive shares and proportions aforesaid mentioned
by metes and bounds, and if in their opin-
ion such partition of said real estate can not
be made in kind without loss or injury
to the parties, then the said Commissioners
shall report that fact to this Court, and the
reasons upon which their opinion is founded,
and the said Commissioners are directed to
make report to Court of their proceedings
under this decree -
