report, doth adjudge order and decree that R. R. Griffin Commissioner
aforesaid, shall unless & Levir, purchaser under a former decree of this
Court, in this cause, of lot designated in Complainants bill as lot one &
shall within thirty days from date of this decree come forward, and
pay the two bonds, with interest thereon, mentioned in the report this day
filed as remaining due and still unpaid, proceed to sell at the risk of
