

do pay to said Commissioner Wm W Briggs within ninety days from the date of this decree a sum of money sufficient to enable him to pay said debts (which he will pay if said money be paid to him for that purpose) the said Wm W Briggs as Sheriff of Southampton County after the expiration of said ninety days will proceed to advertise for sale the said lands of said Warren Edwards which has not been assigned as dower to his widow, situated in said County and described in the papers in this cause and will sell the same to the highest bidder on some County Court day by public auction before the Court house of said County on a credit of eight and sixteen months (except as to enough of the purchase money, or so much thereof if practicable, as may be sufficient to pay the debts as aforesaid to pay the expenses of the sale which he will require in cash and apply in payment of said expenses) After giving notice of said sale for twenty days or more by printed notices posted at various public places in said County and at the door of said Court house, and take of the purchaser separate Bonds with good personal security for the purchase money bearing interest from the day of sale and payable to himself as Sheriff aforesaid eight and sixteen months from the day of sale and file the same with his report which he will make to Court of his proceedings under this decree, and will retain the title to said lands until the further order of Court
