

and the report of Commr J.B. Prince filed Feb'y 4 1882, reporting sale of the land in the proceedings mentioned, and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof no exceptions being filed to said report the same is hereby confirmed and the sale therein reported held firm and binding between the parties. The Court doth further decree that said Comm'r of Sale distribute the balance in his hands from the cash payment among the parties thereto entitled according to their respective interests. And the said Comm'r of Sale will withdraw the two bonds of Wm C. Worrell each for \$897<sup>33</sup> with interest from Nov. 21, 1881 due in one & two years from Nov. 21, 1881, from the papers in this cause, after receipting to the Clerk of this Court for the same, collect the same as they become dues and distribute the fund as collected among the parties entitled. And when all the purchase money is fully paid, the said Comm'r will execute a deed with special warranty to the purchasers and make report to Court.

This day this cause which has been taken for considered as to the defendant, came on to be heard on the complainants bill, the exhibits filed and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that W.W. Briggs who is hereby appointed a special Comm'r for the purpose receive from Sam'l. Butcher the sum of \$501<sup>75</sup> with interest thereon from Jan'y 1, 1874, till paid, subject to following mandate to wit, March 12, 1874 \$3<sup>12</sup>. Dec. 29 1874 \$52<sup>00</sup>. Jan'y 17, 1876 \$50<sup>00</sup>. Jan'y 5, 1877 \$53<sup>00</sup>. Jan'y 15, 1878 for \$115<sup>00</sup> and when the whole of the balance now due on said bond shall have been fully paid by said Butcher or some one for him, that he execute to said Butcher or to such party as he may desire a deed with special warranty for said land. The Court doth further decree that after the collection of said money, the said Comm'r will pay the costs of this suit including an attorney's fee of \$25, to J.B. Prince and the balance, he will pay to Irene A. Worrell, take her receipt therefor and make report to Court of his proceedings. Leave is granted to said Comm'r to withdraw the bonds
