trator d. b. n. of Edward J. Turner dec'd. A. B. Parker,
Mary C. Parker and Joseph W. Island they still fail-
ing to appear plead answer or demurr, and upon
the answers of the defendants Person I. Thomas ad-
ministrator of Thomas B. Powell dec'd. Joseph W.
Prince and T. B. Powell, with the exhibits therewith
filed and general replications to said answers
and was argued by Counsel. On Considerations
whereof the Court without at this time passing upon
any question of law or fact raised in the cause
doth adjudge order and decree that Person I. Thomas
administrator of Thomas B. Powell dec'd. do lay before
one of the Commissioners of this Court an account
of the transactions of his decedent T. B. Powell as
administrator of Edward J. Turner dec'd. which

time and confirmed by this Court by its decree entered
at the November term 1860 in the Cause of Putterton
vs Turner's adm^r then pending in this Court, together
with any matter specially stated deemed pertinent
by himself or which he may be required so to state

give notice of the time and place of taking the
same to the plaintiffs and to the said Person I.
