

W. S. Goodwyn, Executor of the said
Samuel Drury deceased, doth the said sum of \$9 12 with
interest from 1st April 1882 until his further appearance to the
Court that W. S. Goodwyn Executor of Samuel Drury deceased
is indebted to the estate of his said decedent in the sum of
Eight hundred and Eighty three dollars and twenty four cents \$883 24
with interest on eight hundred dollars and Twenty seven cents
(\$800 27) a part thereof from the 1st April 1882 the Court doth
adjudge and decree that the said W. S. Goodwyn Executor
of Samuel Drury deceased do pay and distribute to the same
as follows to wife Louisa R. Drury ^{the wife of the said deceased} Attorney fee
hundred dollars and forty one cents \$141 ^{the amount on her judgment}
16 April 1882 the party to believe of his own proper goods and chattels
and that he pay one third of the residue of the effects & money
to Mary A. Conklyn, another one third of said residue to Sallie
R. Drury and the other one third to Mary Eliza Kindred Joseph
D. Kindred and Delosatt Kindred or their legal guardian
to believe of his own proper goods and chattels And it
further appears from the report of Special Commissioner
W. S. Goodwyn made pursuant to the decree entered herein
at the May term 1882 that out of the proceeds of certain
real estate bonds belonging to the estate of Samuel Drury
one-half by said decree to be sold and to be deposited thereon
reflected on the 24th July 1882 with the Marine Bank of
Norfolk in the name of W. S. Goodwyn Executor the sum
of Seven hundred and two dollars and forty cents bearing
interest at the rate of five per cent per annum, the Court
doth adjudge order and decree that W. S. Goodwyn Special
Commissioner who is hereby authorized to collect a said
sum for his expenses and out of said amount deposit to
the aforesaid pay the unpaid cost of these suits and law
suits and to distribute the residue as follows pay to
Louisa Drury or her attorney one eighth of the residue
pay one third of the balance then remaining to Mary A.
Conklyn one third to Sallie R. Drury and the other one
third to Mary Eliza Kindred Joseph D. Kindred and Delosatt
Kindred or their legal guardian and the said Special Com
missioner shall make report to the Court But the said
W. S. Goodwyn Executor of Samuel Drury deceased and the
said W. S. Goodwyn Special Commissioner as aforesaid
shall not pay to the said legatees and distributees of the
estate of Samuel Drury received the said amount
above decreed to be paid them out of the estate of Samuel
Drury deceased, until they shall have respectively executed
to him as Executor of Samuel Drury a bond worth security
deemed sufficient by him for the penalty of double the
amount to be received by them respectively conditioned
to refund a due proportion of every debt or demand
which may hereafter appear against the said Samuel
Drury and of the cash attending their recovery which
