

doth adjudge order and decree that the said sum of \$912 with
 interest from 1st April 1882 And together appearing to the
 Court that W^o S. Goodwyn Executor of Samuel Dwyer deceased
 is indebted to the estate of his said decedent in the sum of
 Eight hundred and Eighty three dollars and twenty seven cents
 With interest on eight hundred dollars and twenty seven cents
 (\$800⁰⁰) a part thereof from the 1st of April 1882 the Court doth
 adjudge and intend decree that the said W^o S. Goodwyn Executor
 of Samuel Dwyer deceased do pay and distribute to the same
 as follows to wit: To Mrs. John B. Dwyer or her attorney one
 hundred and eighty dollars and fifty cents (\$180⁰⁰) with interest on said sum
 15th April 1882 the said Dwyer or her attorney or her attorney
 and that he pay one third of the residue of the said Samuel Dwyer
 to Mary A. Goodwyn another one third of said residue to Sally
 R. Clifford and the other one third to Mary Eliza Hindard Joseph
 D. Hindard and Antonett Hindard or their legal guardians
 to be paid of his own proper goods and chattels And it
 is further appearing from the report of Special Commissioner
 W^o S. Goodwyn made pursuant to the decree entered herein
 at the May Term 1882 that out of the proceeds of certain
 United States bonds belonging to the estate of Samuel Dwyer
 owned by said decedent to the Court and to be deposited thereon
 deposited on the 24th July 1882 with the Marine Bank of
 Norfolk in the name of W^o S. Goodwyn Executor the sum
 of Seven hundred and two dollars and forty cents bearing
 interest at the rate of five per cent per annum the Court
 doth adjudge order and decree that W^o S. Goodwyn Special
 Commissioner who is hereby authorized to check a bond
 fund for said purpose and out of said amount defray
 as aforesaid pay the unpaid cost of this suit and then
 he pay and distribute the residue as follows: pay to
 Samuel Dwyer or her attorney one eighth of the residue
 pay one third of the balance then remaining to Mary A.
 Goodwyn one third to Sally R. Clifford and the other one
 third to Mary Eliza Hindard Joseph D. Hindard and Antonett
 Hindard or their legal guardians and the said Special Com-
 missioner shall make report to the Court But the said
 W^o S. Goodwyn Executor of Samuel Dwyer deceased and the
 said W^o S. Goodwyn Special Commissioner as aforesaid
 shall not pay to the said legal guardians and distributees of the
 estate of Samuel Dwyer deceased the amount of money
 above decreed to be paid them out of the estate of Samuel
 Dwyer deceased until they shall have respectively executed
 to him as Executor of Samuel Dwyer a bond with security
 deemed sufficient by him for the payment of double the
 amount to be received by them respectively conditioned
 to refund a due proportion of any debts or damages
 which may hereafter appear against the said Samuel
 Dwyer and of the cost attending their recovery which
 said bond he will return and file with the judge
 of these Causes
