This day this Cause came on to be heard on the papers from
the Clerk of the Court read and the report of Commissioner Burdage reporting sale of the house
and lot in Franklin belonging to Estate of Thos Burdage dec^d the portion
of J. P. Crocker & J. B. Crocker's testament purchased by J. P. Crocker showing
value of Mrs Burdage's dower interest marked X and a certificate
from J. P. Crocker giving his consent to let his dower interest in
part of the same and was argued by Counsel. On consideration
whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that the said sale
be good the same together with the report of Commissioner Burdage
to the further decree that J. P. Crocker, Com^r out of the money in his
hands pay first the debts that may be properly proved then pay to
Mrs Burdage or her order six bow of Thos Burdage dec^d the sum
of \$106²⁵ in full of her dower interest and the balance pay to the
parties here to entitled to the receipt thereof and make report to
Court. The said J. P. Crocker is also authorized to withdraw from the
possession in this cause by giving his receipt therefor to the Clerk the
certificate of deposit on Rain & Co for \$841⁰⁰ dated June 26-
1852 collect the same and distribute among the parties
entitled. Should the purchaser desire to anticipate the payment
of the said bond the said Court is authorized to withdraw
the same by giving his receipt to the Clerk and to receive the
money therefor paid to distribute it among the parties en-
titled. And when all the purchase money is paid to execute
added with special warranty to the purchaser and the
said Court will report the proceedings to Court.
