

The Committee taking under their consideration the subject
of providing a suitable and convenient place for the purpose
of collecting a sum sufficient for that purpose from the people
of this County, do a short time ago make a resolution
that each family may contribute one pound of gunpowder
and one pound of lead to the sum to be collected
from the people of this County.

Sum of ten pounds to be paid by the Committee
and of ten pounds to be paid by the Committee
either of them on or before the day of may next for
the purpose aforesaid.

Resolved that Edwin Gray & Henry Taylor do inform the
absent members of this Committee of the preceding resolution
for just them to contribute the aforesaid sum of ten pounds
Resolved that Edwin Gray & Henry Taylor & either of them do so
join as they shall have received the money so contributed
or any other sum that may be voluntarily advanced
for this purpose made application to the Committee
appointed by the late Convention to procure ammunition
as much powder and lead as the money they may
have received will amount to in the proportion of
one pound of powder to four pounds of lead.

John Kirby & John Ingoldsby ^{the Committee} voluntary appeared before this Committee and
acknowledged that they had been guilty of breaching the 1st
article of the association by gaming at the said Kirby,
that they had been guilty of an error in so doing notwithstanding
to obtain concurrence of its evil tendency given willing to refund
all money by them thus now of having signed this Commⁿ of their
future strict compliance with their first compliance with the
second article of the association of the continental Congress
Resolved therefore that the persons aforesaid have been guilty however
of the aforesaid ^{in the Committee} but in consideration of their ~~bad~~ ^{good} behavior before
giving this break of the association & ^{with full satisfaction} behaviour before this
Committee of opinion of hope the public ^{will} not consider them
otherwise as enemies to American Liberty

Resolved that the powder and lead when procured shall be stored on
such convenient place or places as shall be agreed on by the
Committee & be liable to any further directions of the same
