The records show that Francis H. Arthur, not borne as Francis Marian Arthur. private, Company I, 9th Medicent Virginia Infantry, Confederate States arry, enlisted April 17, 1862, at Pinners Point. He was promoted to Surgeant January 1, 1863, and promoted to End Lieutenant april 9, 1864.

Haster roll for July and August. 1864, last roll on file, shows him absent, "Maten prisoner at the battle of Settysburg July 5, 1863.

Union Prisoner of Mar records s by that he was captured July 3, 1863, at lettyshing, confined July 6, 1863, at Fort McHenry, Laryland, received at Fort Delaware, between July 7, and 12, 1863, sent to Point Lookaut, Laryland, October 25, 1863, where he was purpled and received Movember 15, 1864, at Venus Point, Savannah River, by Confederate States agent for exchange. Union records also show that he was cared april 1, 1865, at Dimeiddie Court House, Firstnia, receivel [171] 5, 1865, at Old Capitol Prison, Vashington, T. G., sent to Johnson's Island world 9, 1865, where he was released June 17, 1865, on taking the Oath of where to the United States.

The residence is shown as Portsmuth, Virginia, and 03 years, complexion fuir, hair light, owne blue, height 5 feet 3 lations.
