Convention on April 26, 1865. The
date & place of capture or surrender,
and parole, not stated. The roll is
not dated.

Not found as Richard Alexander
Barrett.

Nor has the name been found on the
muster rolls of Co. D, 31st N. C. Inf.
O. S. A., which rolls partly cover the
period from Sept. 18, 1861 to Nov. &
Dec., 1864, dated Feb. 18, 1865.
