The records show that James E. Britt, Co. H, 41st. Virginia Inf., U.S.A., enlisted March 2, 1862, at Norfolk, Va. Drafted from the Militia, April 11, 1862 & assigned from the Militia.

Muster roll Sept. & Oct. 1864, (latest on file,) shows him present, a Private.

His name appears on a Receipt Roll for clothing for 4th. Qr., 1864. Date of issue: Dec. 23, 1864.

His name appears on a List of Confederate prisoners who have been paroled not to take up arms against the United States Government until regularly exchanged.

List not dated. Rank: Private.

(Indorsement on List: Hdqrs. 9th. A.O., Provost Marshal's Office, at Burkesville Junction, Va., on the 14, 15, 16 and 17th. days of April, 1865.)

Not found as James Elbert Britt.

George E. Beaton was Captain of the company.
