The records show that Alexander M. Brownley, not borne as Alexander Marshall Brownley, private, Company D, 9th Regiment Virginia Infantry, Confederate States Army, enlisted April 27, 1861, at Portsmouth, age 19 years.

He was transferred March 24, 1862, to Captain Thompson's Company, Virginia Light Artillery, (Portsmouth Light Artillery), (formerly Captain Grimes' Company).

Muster roll of that Company for July and August, 1862, last roll on file, shows him present.

He was transferred October 8, 1862, to Captain Moore's Company Virginia Light Artillery.

Muster roll for January and February, 1865, last roll on file, shows him present.

Union Prisoner of War records show that he was captured April 2, 1865, at Petersburg, and was released June 24, 1865, at Point Lookout, Maryland, on taking the Oath of Allegiance to the United States.

His residence is shown as Portsmouth, Virginia, complexion light, hair brown, eyes light blue, height 5 feet 8 inches.
