The records show that Solomon C. Myrick, Private, Company G, 3 Regiment Virginia Infantry, Confederate States Army, enlisted April 22, 1864, at Greenville.

Musters roll for July and August 1864, last on file, shows him absent a Prisoner of War.

He was paroled at Point Lookout, Maryland, and transferred to Aiken's Landing, Virginia, March 14, 1865, for exchange. Exchanged March 15, 1865. No later record has been found.
