The records show that W.R.L. Cobb, Co. L, 62nd Georgia Cav., C.S.A., enlisted Jan. 1 1863, at Franklin, Va.

(This Co. appears to have been divided about Feb. 17, 1864, becoming Cos. D & E, 8th (Dearing's) Confederate Cavalry)

W.R.L. Cobb, became a Private of Co. E, 8th. (Dearing's) Confederate Cavalry.

Mustor roll Dec. 31, 1863 to May 1, 1864, (latest on file) shows him present, a Pvt.

(This Co. became Co. K, 24th Va. Cav., C.S.A., about June 8, 1864, the 8th. (Dearing's) Confederate cavalry, having been disbanded about April 29, 1864).

Mustor roll Co. K, 24th Va. Cav., C.S.A., for Sept. & Oct. 1864, dated Nov. 12, 1864, (latest on file) shows him present, a Private.

Capture, parole or later record not found.
