The records show that John R. Dillon, not borne as John Richard Dillon, private, Gaptain Gordon's Company, 1st (Olmstead's) Regiment Georgia Infantry, Confederate States Army, enlisted May 14, 1862, at Thunderbolt Battery. This company subsequently became Company B, 13th Bottelion Georgia Infantry, which later became Company K, 63rd Regiment Georgia Infantry. He was transferred December 6, 1862, to Company D, same regiment. Euster roll for Jonuary and February, 1864, last roll on file, shows him a stratest. Other records show that clothing was issued to him for the 2nd quarter, 1864, date of issue April 27, 1864.

No later record has been found.
