The records show that John R. Dillon, not borne as John Richard Dillon, private, Captain Gordon's Company, 1st (Olmstead's) Regiment Georgia Infantry, Confederate States Army, enlisted May 14, 1862, at Thunderbolt Battery.

This company subsequently became Company B, 13th Battalion Georgia Infantry, which later became Company K, 63rd Regiment Georgia Infantry.

He was transferred December 6, 1862, to Company D, same regiment.

Musters roll for January and February, 1864, last roll on file, shows him absent, in arrest.

Other records show that clothing was issued to him for the 2nd quarter, 1864, date of issue April 27, 1864.

No later record has been found.
