The records show that Luther R. Edwards, private, Company H. 5th Regiment Virginia Cavalry (12 months, 1861-2)(4th Virginia Cavalry, Mullins' Regiment), Confederate States Army, enlisted May 7, 1861, at Jerusalem.

He was appointed 2nd Lieutenant Eay 19, 1862.

About June 26, 1862, this company became Company A, 13th Regiment Virginia Cavalry (16th Battalion Virginia Cavalry, 5 Virginia Cavalry, 12 months, 1861-1862).

He was promoted to 1st Lieutenant February 20, 1865.

Muster roll for November and December, 1864, last roll on file, shows him present.

His name appears on a record of Paroled Prisoners of War remaining in Biohmond, Virginia, Under heading, "Annesty Oath administered to Paroled Prisoners." Date May 23, 1865, residence Southampton County, Virginia.

No later record has been found.
