Dear Sir:-

I H.K.Williams of Company D. 3rd Virginia Infantry do certify that B.F.Felts was a good and true soldier in the same Company with myself and that he served in the war I think I can say until the surrender. The last time I saw him in the army was on Saturday night April 1st 1865. When we were engaged in a battle at Five Forks Dinwiddie County, Virginia. at that time we were surrounded and got scattered. and did not get together any more. At the surrender I do not think there were more than ten or fifteen of the ~~company~~ company at Appomattox Court House. Not an officer of the Company present.

I think I can safely say that he did not desert.
