Point, and was reported on Union
Prisoner of War records as cap-
tured Apr. 7, 1865, at Ford's Sta-
tion, Va. His name appears on a
Register of refugees and rebel
deserters, which shows that he
was received April 12, 1865, and
that he took the oath and trans-
portation was furnished to
Southampton Co., Va.
