Answering your letter of recent date concerning the record of your father, Mr. Sylvanus Hines, as a Confederate soldier, I beg to state that neither the records in Richmond or Washington ^{show} the date of his being wounded; neither do these records show that he was wounded.

By other research among the records we are, however, able to approve the claim which will be done this week, and a check will be sent to Mrs. Hines for \$19.00 to pay for the quarter, beginning June 1st, in which the claim was received. We will also send a check for the same amount for the quarter beginning September 1st. Pensions are payable every three months, the full amount allowed for the year is \$76.00.
