(roll on file) William Johnson, sgt. i, who was in it. No record earlier or later record has been found. No record has been found of the muster into the O.S.A. service of an orgn known as Co. C, 3rd Regt. V.I. Jr. Reserves Col. J. J. Hinsdale is shown to have been in command of the 3rd Inf'tn. H.Q. Jr. Reserves.
