The records show that John T. Joyner
Private, Company I, 41 Virginia In-
fantry, Confederate States Army, en-
listed April 10, 1862, at Sewell's
Point. Muster roll for September
& October 1864, last on file, shows
him absent prisoner.

Prisoner of War Records show him
captured at Petersburg, October 27,
1864, and paroled at Point Lookout,
Maryland, February 18, 1865.

His name is borne on a muster roll
of a detachment of paroled and ex-
changed prisoners at Camp Lee, near
Richmond, Virginia, which is dated
February 25, 1865.
