

INSTRUCTIONS.

BE READ BEFORE THE FORM IS FILLED IN.

A widow married after May 1, 1868, is not entitled to a pension.

It is necessary to have Certificates A, B, D and F filled out in full. All questions must be answered. If comrade cannot be found to fill in Certificate B, then Certificate C must be filled.

Where there is a camp of Confederate Veterans, the Camp Certificate E must be filled.

When there is no camp, then Certificate F must be filled.

When the name of the applicant, or any one making affidavit, is made by X mark, a witness must always be had to the mark.

After this application is completed file it with the clerk of the Circuit Court of your county.
