In considering your claim for a pension, which has been sent to this office, I beg to state that we are unable to find any record of your service as a Confederate soldier among the official war records to which we, under the law, are required to refer. It will help your case if you will have H. A. Savedge and E. E. Sebrell, who claim to have been your comrades, to write out a statement showing to the best of their knowledge what they know of your service as a Confederate soldier and about when and under what circumstances you finally left the army. The information we are short of to prove your right to pension is sufficient information from reliable sources who know of your service, or from the official war records.
