The records show that Lucius L. Mary, not borne as Lucius L. Harry, private, Ownary G. Gist Regiment Virginia Infantry (Wilsom's Regiment Virginia Infantry 7th Wilson's Buttalion Virginia Infantry), Confederate States Arry, was enrolled Februry 3, 1862, at Franclin, Virginia, age 16 years. He was discharged Hovember 1, 1862, at Gulpeper by reason of Conscript act, being under uge.

Littleberry 7. Muson was Captain of the above named organisation. Lajor Batt has not been identified.

The records also show that L. Laury, not borne as Lucius L. Manry, private, 2nd Company K, 10th Regiment Virginia Cavalry, Confederate States army, enlisted January 15, 1834, at Petg. Muster roll for July and August, 1864, last roll on file, shows him present. Other records show that clothing was issued to him for the 4th Quarter, 1864, date of issue December 51, 1864. No later record has been found.

There are no muster rolls on file of Company D, 44th Suttalion Virginia Infantry, Confederate States Army, and no record has been found of the service of a run named Lucius L. Manry or Maury as a member of that organization,
