The records show that Lucius L. Murry, not borne as Lucius L. Murry, private, Company C, 51st Regiment Virginia Infantry (Wilson's Regiment Virginia Infantry 7th Wilson's Battalion Virginia Infantry), Confederate States Army, was enrolled February 3, 1862, at Franklin, Virginia, age 18 years. He was discharged November 1, 1862, at Culpeper by reason of Conscript act, being under age.

Littleberry W. Mason was Captain of the above named organization. Major Butt has not been identified.

The records also show that L. Murry, not borne as Lucius L. Murry, private, 2nd Company H, 10th Regiment Virginia Cavalry, Confederate States Army, enlisted January 15, 1864, at Petz. Muster roll for July and August, 1864, last roll on file, shows him present. Other records show that clothing was issued to him for the 4th quarter, 1864, date of issue December 31, 1864. No later record has been found.

There are no muster rolls on file of Company D, 44th Battalion Virginia Infantry, Confederate States Army, and no record has been found of the service of a man named Lucius L. Murry or Murry as a member of that organization.
