The records show that James P. Whitfield, Private, Captain William E. Barnes Company (Isle of Wight Avengers), subsequently Company "F", 61 Regiment Virginia Infantry, Confederate States Army, was enlisted March 20, 1862, at Isle of Wight County, Virginia, by Captain W. E. Barnes.

Company Muster Roll for September and October, 1864, last on file, shows him present.

He was surrendered by General Robert E. Lee and paroled April 9, 1865, at Appomattox Court House, Virginia.
