INSTRUCTIONS.

READ BEFORE THE FORM IS FILLED IN.

It is necessary to have Certificates A, B, D and F filled out in full. All questions must be answered.
If estimate cannot be found to fill in Certificate B, then Certificate C must be filled.
Where there is a camp of Confederate Veterans, the Camp Certificate E must be filled.
When there is no camp, then Certificate F must be filled.
When the name of the applicant, or any one making affidavit, is made by X mark, a witness must always be
had to the mark.
The doctor, in filling in Certificate I, must set out clearly his examination, and when he declines to exam, whether
partial or total, he must follow the wording of the Act, otherwise the rating of the pensioner cannot be properly
determined.
After the application is complete file it with the clerk of the Circuit or Corporation Court of your county or city.
