The records show that Irvin O.
(not found as Irvin Cross) Wills, 2
Lieut., Co. H, 5 Va. Cav., U.S.A., en-
listed at Jerusalem May 7, 1861, and
was promoted 1st. Lieut. May 22, 1862.

This company became a part of
the 13 Va. Cav., U.S.A., June 26, 1862,
and the name Irvin O. Wills is borne
on the rolls of Co. A of that Regt.
with the ranks of 1 Lieut. and Capt.
He was elected Capt. Feb. 20, 1863.

Union Prisoner of War records
show that as Capt., Co. A, 13 Va. Cav.,
U.S.A., he was paroled at Appomattox
Court House, Va., Apr. 9, 1865.
