 20th March & that they will with the greatest energy recommend
 the measures then agreed to by such Convention to the people

Resolved that the general members of this County

 the sum of ten pounds to promote the meeting
 of fifteen pounds for the use of the delegates in the
 Congress to be held in May next that such money
 be collected be immediately paid by the general coin
 the hands of Edwin Gray & Henry Taylor to be by them
 transmitted to R. C. Nicholas for the purpose afores^d

 the election of delegates to represent this county in provincial
 Congress at the Courthouse of this County Resolved that a
 copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Clergy men in
 the different parishes of this County & that they be requested
 to publish the same in their respective churches & that
 the Clerk of this Comm^{ty} advertise the same at the Courthouse
 at the next Court

 appointed to conduct the election of the S. delegates

Resolved that the thanks of this Committee be given to Edwin Gray
 Henry Taylor our worthy and patriotic delegates & officers
 whom that we are perfectly satisfied with their conduct in the
 execution of that important trust & that they have done
 themselves entirely to the satisfaction of this Committee
