The prisoner being set to the bar and arraigned as aforesaid
plead not guilty whereupon Rivers witness ^{was} examined
& the prisoner heard in his own defence ^{in the case} it is the
opinion of the Court (the goods being of the value of 20/7) that
the prisoner is guilty of felony but intitled to the benefit of clergy
that he now receive in open court be burnt in the hand
that he also receive on his bare back 39 lashes and it is
ordered that the sheriff see the same performed.
