Notice to Bishop or Comptred by Wm. Horne Chy. Horne  
to the Pres. & Council on Consideration whereof it is  
voted forord that the 2<sup>nd</sup> Comptred given over to the  
Court shall be the 2<sup>nd</sup> in his hands belonging to  
the fact he made thereof as wide date for his  
Report to the Attorney at Law, the P. Comptred to make  
a Report to the value of slaves which descended to the

2d Chy. to be paid to the slaves  
Horn and his heirs who are considered as  
slaves & giving that Bishop & others John Wilberforce  
legally took or any two of them to examine the acts of  
the 2<sup>nd</sup> Court and make division of the slaves of their

slaves according to an estimate of this Committee  
or the compleat list to be furnished from the records of  
the Court by the Clerk thereof and make report to  
the next quarterly court in order to a final decree  
on the action of Chy. 2<sup>nd</sup> to be left for action on the 2<sup>nd</sup>  
of December Day till the same is filed in the Court  
or going to be in the Office of the Secy. of the Court

Bishopship implying a right of Mr. George this City

among them in order to a final decree
