On the motion of Mary Bradthams widow of Henry Bradthams a fornicator in Dabney's Lyins who died in the service of this Commonwealth she is allowed the sum of £10. for her funeral, & it is ordered that the shiff pay her the said £10.

Ordered that Saml Hades be a ff. member of the road from the mill pit to the garden meeting house, Charles Bennett for the traveller spring to the garden meeting house between Bennett from the balin Swamp to Bennett's shop.

Ordered that for Washington, Henry & Breach & W<sup>m</sup> Highin & any 2 be the repair of the said bridge at the church & repair the road that the road be repaired till court in course.
