And here is shown a bill of exchange on the bill, various disbursements and payments of the consuls on both sides, on consideration whereof it is decreed & ordered that the defendant William de deliver to the plaintiff the slave Mrs. Frank and Louis on the bill mentioned, & it is further ordered & decreed that the said def^t do make up his account respecting the heirs of the said slaves & also respecting the other personal estate of the testator Joshua Williams and of the said Thomas Clements before John Simmons Wm Thomas Mark Richardson, Joshua Fort & Richard Clements & William Chambliss or any two of them who are hereby appointed commissioners to state, audit & examine the same & that the said commissioners now do proceed to state the said accounts & report the balance due for the same to this court in order to a final decree.

that the balance thereof being £1350 be sealed at 90 for one which will reduce the act £132. 12. 6. pence & leave the balance due the plaintiff £266. 12. 6. pence which sum it is ordered & decreed by this court the said def^t pay unto the said plaintiff ^{at the City of New York} from which party ^{the said} ^{plaintiff} he forgoes any appeal &c. (To give bond in 1 Mo) ^{if full made.}
