the 15th day of May 1792.

Ordered that the treasurer pay unto Abram Dawson, the
sum of £ 55. 12. 6 for rebuilding Taylor bridge, the sum off
to give the said bridge having apaided that the same was
completed according to agreement, and set thereof with the cost
being a sum of Reuben Hill's estate returned and \$ 0.

Samuel Johnson, Jas. Adams, Samuel Francis, Jas. Lins-
bury, Frederic Parker, William Harris, John Reed, Jonathan
Dexter, Stephen Rice, Jonathan Adams for lots, Jonathan
Leverett, John Edwards, Nodell Edwards, Ding Faircloth,
Jas. Alderman, James Barnes and Hardy Johnson were
sworn a grand jury of inquest on the body of this county
and having examined their charge went out of court and after
a long examination and made the following presentments
