Westbrook v Westbrook Chy Heard on the bill and answer

Madill v Lanier Chy. The defendant not having entered
his appearance according to an act of assembly in that case
made and provided and the rules of this court the plaintiff
bill is taken for confessed whereupon it is decreed and ordered
that ^{William Edwards} Roy: Bland, Thomas Edwards, Arthur Turner and
Thomas Holmday or any three make sale of the negroes and
horses in the bill mentioned at public auction giving each of
months credit ^{until the 25th day of Decr next} & taking bond with sufficient security, and that
the def^t & all persons may be for ever foreclosed of and from
all equity of redemption or claim in or to the said slaves and
horses and that the estate of the complet, and the purchaser or
purchasers may become absolute therein & make report, &

Scotts Case, v Aringtons heirs Chy Heard on the bill

public auction giving 9 Mos credit ^{take bond &c} and that the def^t may
