

It is the opinion of the court that the said injunction be dissolved  
according the sum of £ 2,10.4/6 with interest from December  
15<sup>th</sup> 1788.

Westbrook v Westbrook Ch<sup>r</sup>g Heard on the bill and answer  
whereupon it is decreed and ordered that John Simmons &  
Robert Taylor, Mark Nicolson & Jobulon Lewis or any three  
of them attell appear and tell apart the slaves of Private  
Westbrook widow & relief of Henry Westbrook dead in the  
lands slaves & personal estate of her dead husband and  
make equal division of the remaining lands and slaves &  
personal estate equally between the complainants & ~~the~~  
the defendant William according to law. Sept<sup>r</sup>.

Madill v Lanier Ch<sup>r</sup>g The defendant not having entered  
his appearance according to an act of assembly in that case  
made and provided and the cause of his death the plaintiff  
bill is taken for confessed whereupon it is decreed and ordered  
that Sam<sup>l</sup> Blunt, <sup>Miles Dugan</sup> Thomas Edwards, Arthur Turner and  
Thomas Holliday or any three make sale of the negroes and  
horses in the bill mentioned at public auction giving credit of  
<sup>until the 25<sup>th</sup> day Dec<sup>r</sup> next</sup> months credit & taking bond with sufficient security, and that  
the def<sup>d</sup> & all persons may be for ever foreclosed of and from  
all equity of redemption or claim in or to the said slaves and  
horses and that the estate of the comit and the partners or  
bankers may become absolute therein & make report to  
Scotts Estate, or Anrigton heirs Ch<sup>r</sup>g Heard on the bill  
and answer whereupon it is decreed and ordered that Miles  
Gary, John Simmons (of Charley) W<sup>t</sup>. Simmons & Micajah  
Allen or any 3 make sale of the lands in the bill mentioned at  
public auction giving of 12 mo credit <sup>for & before</sup> and that the def<sup>d</sup> may  
be for ever foreclosed of all equity of redemption
