lases parish & County levies in future.

Ordered that the court be adjourned till the court in course.

ampton on Friday the 15th day of July 1796 for the trial of
Samoa negro man slave belonging to Miles Lang of this county,
for having profaned, violated & administered medicines contrary
to laws.

was heretofore committed and charged with the felony aforesaid
and plead not guilty. When his divers witnesses were examined
on consideration whereof it is the opinion of the court that he
be acquitted & it is ordered that the shiff set the prisoner forthwith at
liberty.
