 that the slaves Sam, Isaac, Kater Isaac, and Perry this day condemned
 by the sentence of this court were purchased by Ben Drew & Wm
 Boykin in the state of Maryland to wit Fd Sam by Wm Boykin
 and the other three by Ben Drew and imported into this State within
 three months ^{last past} that the said Sam was sold by Wm Boykin & the
 others ^{three} by Ben Drew to Haniel Spears and Joshua Butte ^{apostles}
 citizens of the state of Georgia who knew the said slaves were so
 imported that the ^s Spears & Butte were conveying the slaves
 with many others ^{this} to Georgia or some of the
 Southern states when the murder was committed ^{for} which they
 are condemned and the Court conceiving that such importations
 of slaves are contrary to the spirit and meaning of the existing
 laws of this state direct and order that the circumstances aforesaid
 be represented and certified to the executive.
