



The affidavit of John Shollen in the
suit Duncan Turnbule vs Thomas Jones's Ex
or Adm^r in the County Court of Southampton

This Deponent saith that he
made application on behalf of Duncan
Turnbule to the said Thomas Jones in his
lifetime, this deponent thinks some time in
the year 1798, for the settlement of his the
said Jones account with the said Duncan
Turnbule - he then told this Deponent that
he wished to have his acct settled, but that
it could not be done with any person
but Messrs Cole, the former attorney of the
said company - that after seeing the said Messrs
Cole provision should be made for the
payment of the balance. - As well as
this Deponent remembers he saw the
said Jones two or three times on the subject
of his debt to the said Duncan Turnbule
and he always assured this Deponent that
the said Jones also informed this Deponent
that the said debt should have been paid
long before, only for some unfortunate cir-
cumstances. -
