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After closing and the prisoner being asked if he had any
words to examine or any further or other defence to make
to which he replied he had not the Court therefore on consi-
deration of the evidence the arguments of counsel and
the whole circumstances of the case are unanimously of opinion
that the prisoner is guilty of the murder aforesaid and it is
ordered that he be taken from hence to the place from
whence he came and from thence ^{Thursday} on the 10 day of Sept
next to the usual place of execution and there between
the hours of 12 and 3 in the afternoon of that day be
hung by the neck till he is dead &c
