The prisoner was set to the bar by the sheriff of the County
and charged with the offence aforesaid to which he pleaded not guilty
and thereupon came divers witnesses to wit Hardy Dayall and Saml
Calvert who were examined touching the prisoner and the prisoner
heard by Counsel in his own defence whereupon it is considered by the Court
that the prisoner ought to be tried for the said offence at the
next Court to be holden for the County

✓ It is remembered that Hardy Dayall and Saml Calvert
of the County of Southampton came into Court and personally acknow-
ledged themselves to be indebted to John Page Esq. Governor of the
Commonwealth of Virginia. and to his Successors for the time being
in the sum of three hundred and thirty four dollars each of them
respective Bonds and Tenement Goods and Chattell to be levied and
to the said Governor, and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth
to be paid upon this condition that ^{the said Hardy Dayall} they and each of them
and Saml Calvert son of the above named Saml Calvert as aforesaid shall
do personally appear before the Justices of the County at the next
Quarterly Court at the Court house in the town of Jerusalem to
them to give evidence as they and each of them know against Sam
Ben concerning the matter whereunto he is charged, and that they
do not depart without leave of the said Court, then this recog-
nizance to be void due to be in full force.
